Academic Senate

Michael Flaherty highlighted reports received at Academic Senate as follows. Curriculum reported that English and Rhetoric have updated testing requirements, and Math will be updated in May. Academic & Scholastic Standards continues to work on the finals schedule. Academic Support continues its work on ensuring that all faculty who teach developmental courses have a peer mentor. Campus Quality expressed concern about how online and courses using Blackboard will be assisted next year. Dr. Flaherty was the sole nominee for Academic Senate President.
