Come On In!

At the Triton College Housing Office we will assist you in your housing search while you pursue your quality Triton education. By maintaining a list of area accommodations — from apartments to houses to condominiums we can assist you in securing a home conveniently located near the Triton campus. Read on for more details.

Location

Triton is located in River Grove, Ill., a western suburb of Chicago — so your housing facility will be near area entertainment and businesses, including stores, theaters, parks and recreation centers.

Transportation

Public transportation is available to the campus; allow 20 to 30 minutes of traveling time to reach Triton from your housing facility. Parking is available if you drive to class.

Housing Costs

Rental costs fluctuate within the district and depend on the type of rental option you choose. Rental options include apartment (studio, one or two bedrooms) and rooms in a home.

Depending on which you choose and if you decide to have roommates, you should budget at least \$600 to \$1,000 for the first month's rent and security deposit. For specific ranges in the variety of costs of rental options, call the Housing Office at (708) 456-0300, Ext. 3616.

Utilities, except for telephone service, currently average 50 to 90 a month.

You are responsible for setting appointments to view the rental option of your choice and reaching an agreement with the landlord.
