What is ICATT?

ICATT is a 2-3 year training program which is modeled after Germany's apprenticeship system, designed to meet top industry standards. ICATT combines theory, practice and work experience to build a globally competitive workforce.

ICATT uses industry-defined competencies and requirements as well as a standardized curriculum aligned to the German "training profile" in the respective occupation. These standards are developed by teams of highly skilled experts and include comprehensive written and practical examinations.

ICATT is a well-rounded and attractive program in which apprentices receive an associate degree, an internationally recognized DIHK certificate along with possible DoL certification and other US accreditations.

ICATT Basic Structure

- A maximum of 15 students per college cohort, made up of apprentices from different companies
- Training schedules tailored to company needs and requirements of participating colleges
- Administration of written and practical examinations by GACC Midwest after the second and third year of training (final examinations part 1 and part 2)
- Standardized curriculum based on internationally recognized German standards amended to US needs and work laws
- 2 year employment guarantee upon successful completion of the training program*
- Participating ICATT companies agree to provide company specific hands-on training, college tuition, stipend while in school and hourly wages
