TRIO- Student Support Services. - \$219,672 per year for 5 years. These funds will support the continuation of Triton's TRIO Student Support Services (SSS) program. The goal of the program is to increase the college retention and graduation rates of its participants. The program will serve 160 students per year. This is Triton's 2nd cycle of funding for 5 years.
