As we approach the end of the fall semester, please ensure you're on track with your grant expenditures. A few basic tips on managing your grant funds follows:

- ✓ Monitor grant expenditures monthly to ensure that over-spending or under-spending can be addressed before the end of the grant period.
- ✓ If the original grant budget requires a modification in order to support the purpose of the grant, contact the GDO immediately for information about the budget modification process.

✓ Never use funds from a grant for items not included in the grant budget or for purposes other than described in the grant narrative.
