Program Prerequisites

- _____ PHY100 (General Physics) or DMS100 (Introduction to Imaging Physics)
- _____ MAT085 (Algebra and Geometry II) or must meet current college math requirement for completion of MAT085
- _____ BIS240 (Human Anatomy and Physiology I)
- _____ AHL120 (Comprehensive Medical Terminology)

Completion of the Allied Health, Math and Science prerequisites must not be more than 5 years old.

All prerequisite coursework must be completed with a grade of "C" or better.

All test scores must be within the last two years.

General Education requirements

Students awaiting admission to the program are strongly encouraged to complete all other general education requirements prior to entering the program which are required for graduation.
