## Grants Update

Triton College has been awarded a Title V Grant, *Achieving Equity in Educational Outcomes for Hispanic and Low Income Students*, in the amount of \$2.7 million over five years! This funding affords the college an opportunity to make systemic change and put into action curricular reform, student success measures, and guided pathways to benefit all students in their higher education journey. Congratulations were expressed to the Grants Development Office and all departments and individuals who were involved in the proposal.



### Chairman's Report

Chairman Stephens reported that the FY 19 Budget will be amended to reflect the revenues received in a recent bandwidth sale agreement.

Mr. Stephens discussed improvements to be completed in the A Building, including re-finishing of the terrazzo flooring and cosmetic upgrades on the main floor as well as sprucing up the first floor restrooms.

## Action Exhibits/Purchasing Schedules Approved

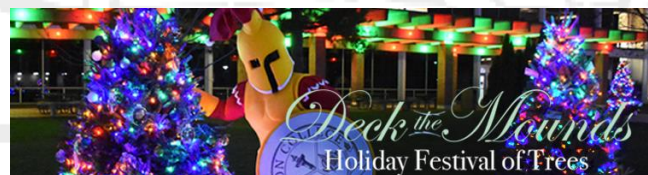
